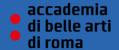

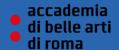

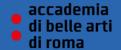

EMERGING ARc Collection Workshop:

Ph.D. students experiencing art research on Emerging Site

In this workshop students will get familiar with main driven questions of the EMERGING project, objectives and the a major output – the ARC collection site. EMERGING project is now on the final stage of testing ARc Academic Artistic Research collection coming from the PhD theoretical- practice art theses of the Portuguese University Repositories. The site will be presented still in an early phase to be tested by potential users. The EMERGING team will offer a brief introduction of the site and features as well as the main concept guiding the selection criterium for choosing artistic works that emerge from the written theses as epistemic objects. Students are invited to bring their objects and interest of previous research/ art production, to search, explore and use the site of the ARc collection as a tool for their works in progress or to refine their aims and subjects of research or to trigger the curiosity into potential subjects of artistic research.

Students will be testing the platform while searching through key-words to get contents of their research interests and will get to know features of the collection that may match their expectations. Site should be accessed from each student's device – mobile, tablet or Pc. It is required a room with internet access.

At the end, students are free to give feedback on their users experience regarding the ARc collection, namely the information available, comment on the structure of the site, the paths.

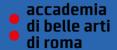
